IMPORTANT: Applicants for this scholarship must be planning to enter a college major in the teaching profession. Applicants must write a letter to the committee explaining their career goals and how they plan to achieve them. Applicants must tell why they believe they should be selected for this scholarship. Include: School and community activities, service work, plus any experiences dealing with teaching children, ie, tutoring, camp counselor, Bible school, etc. This letter should also include a statement of financial need. An ACT score of at least 20 is required.

In addition, applications must be accompanied by two letters of recommendation from school personnel and a current transcript from both their high school and college if already in college.

Applications should be returned to the school Guidance Office by the date set by the Guidance Office. Finalists will be selected by the members of the JCRTA scholarship committee and arrangements will be made with the applicant for a mandatory interview by the committee.
